**Fourth Wind4All CEDIF Sells Out!**

Wind4All Communities IV Inc. (“**Wind4All**”) successfully closed their CEDIF Offering on February 27, 2015 having raised the maximum of \$3,000,000 – all from Nova Scotian investors.

Wind4All will invest the net proceeds of the CEDIF into the Barrachois Community Wind Farm; a two-turbine 4 MW wind farm, located in Cape Breton. The wind farm is already under construction, and is due to be fully operational this coming summer.

The project was developed under Nova Scotia’s COMFIT program, and through a power purchase agreement with Nova Scotia Power, 100% of the power produced will be used locally, by the surrounding communities for the next 20 years.

The Barrachois Community Wind Farm is being developed by Natural Forces, a Maritime-owned wind energy company established in 2001 and based in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Natural Forces have in excess of 40 years of combined experience in the wind industry and have been involved in numerous projects across the Maritime Provinces.
